

Third-Level Domain Names in the .ng namespace.

To make an appropriate third-level domain name tied to a particular State in Nigeria, you simply use the code for that state, and append the relevant second and top-level domain to it.

Examples

A Government Ministry in Benue State would be “housing.be.gov.ng”.

A Secondary school in Kaduna State would be “school.kd.sch.ng”

Remember that they are case-insensitive.
